#### **4. Annecy, France: General Archives of the Missionaries of St. Francis de Sales (AMSFS).**

In the absence of a provincial archive and diocesan archive, the General Archives of the Missionaries of St. Francis de Sales, Annecy is the only source for the History of the Catholic Church in Orissa. The archives contain letters addressed to the superior general. Besides a narration of their journeys, the missionaries' letters of 'self-evaluation' of their work as missionaries, and life as religious are also conserved. The archives conserve some of the letters and reports of the bishops and superiors of the mission.

These two volumes are a collection of documents from the early evangelisation of Gangpur up to the arrival of the SVD Missionaries (Society of the Divine Word) in 1948. The collection consists of diaries of the first parishes and of the individual Missionaries and the official letters relating to the establishment of the mission stations. Though uncritical and more often the translation from French into English is defective, the collection is one of the most important sources for a History of the Gangpur Mission.
